**Architecture:**

Enclosed projects where a minimum 50% of the enclosure is new/restored/replaced or civic infrastructure at various scales.

**Interior Architecture:**

Includes projects within an existing enclosure, interior exhibits/installations, with minor exterior replacement/restoration/revision.

**A project may be submitted for Architecture OR Interior Architecture, but not both.**
